Diagnosis and Management of Orofacial Pain—Tricks of the Trade for the General Practitioner

This course will undertake to provide an overview of the examination and diagnosis techniques utilized by the Mount Sinai Hospital Facial Pain Clinic in Toronto. It will also review the pharmacological and non-pharmacological management of various facial pain conditions, along with the latest research emanating from the centre. Participants will garner a basic understanding of the issues and complications surrounding the management of temporomandibular disorders and other orofacial pain conditions.

Dr. Michael Goldberg is currently an Associate Professor in the Discipline of Periodontics at the University of Toronto's Faculty of Dentistry. He is the Deputy Dentist-in-Chief and is the clinical director of the Centre for Advanced Dental Research and Care (CADRC) at Mount Sinai Hospital, which includes the Severe and Refractory Periodontal Disease Treatment Unit. Dr. Goldberg is also director of the Implant Monitoring Clinic at the Faculty of Dentistry, which incorporates the development of strategies for the management of peri-implant disease. In addition, he is the head of the division of Periodontology as well as an associate in the Wasser Pain Management Centre at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto. Dr.

Goldberg is in private specialty practice, limited to periodontics and implant surgery, in downtown Toronto.
