

# Topic : Restorative dentistry: A review of concepts and protocols

**Abstract:** This presentation is designed to share with clinicians current literature and evidence of clinical protocols done every day in restorative dentistry. The course will explain with scientific evidence the “how” and “why” of the steps to follow in fabrication of direct and indirect restorations.

Preparations design, material selection and bonding protocols will be reviewed and discussed.

- Understand the changes on preparation design and the importance of conservative dental treatment
- Recognize most available materials for direct and indirect restorations and their indications and contraindications
- Implement clinical protocols that will increase the longevity of restorative procedures
